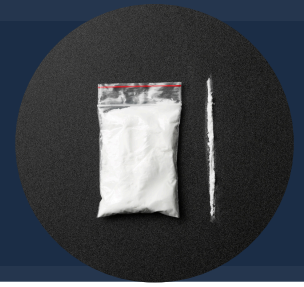


METHAMPHETAMINE

Methamphetamine accounted for over 12,500 overdose deaths in 2018

APPEARANCE

Meth can come in many forms, including: Crystals, powder, and tablets/pills.

OVERDOSE CAN LEAD TO:

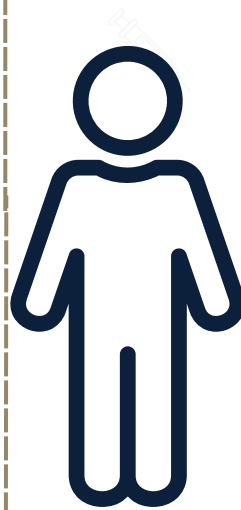
- Heart Attack
- Cardiac arrest
- Hypertensive Crisis
- Stroke



52.9% of adults who reported using meth in the past year had a methamphetamine use disorder



Meth messes with brain dopamine, flooding it and messing up normal function



USING METH LONG TERM CAN CAUSE:

- Aggressive Behaviors
- Psychosis
- Memory Loss
- Paranoia
- Visual and Auditory Hallucinations

In case of an overdose call 911 and if possible administer naloxone (Narcan)

*Methamphetamine is not an opioid; naloxone does not always reverse its effects. Experts recommend administering naloxone if someone is suffering from drug poisoning.
