## What is Xylazine?

Xylazine is a veterinary tranquilizer not approved for human use

## STREET NAMES

- Tranq
- Tranq dope when combines with heroine or fentanyl

## APPEARANCE

Xylazine can appear as a white or brown powder

## ROUTES OF ADMINISTRATION

- Intravenous
- Intramuscular
- Intranasal
- Oral



Xylazine leaves users with necrotic ulcers because it restricts blood flow through skin tissue. The ulcers tend to be on the legs and arms



Xylazine has been found in the illicit drug supply, frequently mixed with fentanyl



## USING XYLAZINE WILL LEAD TO:

- Drowsiness
- Amnesia
- Slow Breathing
- Low blood pressure
- Loss of consciousness
- Loss of physical sensation

**In case of an overdose  
call 911 and if possible  
administer naxolone (Narcan)**

**\*Xylazine is not an opioid; naloxone does not always reverse its effects.**

**Experts recommend administering naloxone if someone is suffering from drug poisoning.**
